
The adjoining site to the west, fronting onto Dyke Road, is in the control of the LDA who have a Three Phase MasterplanThree Phase Masterplan to develop a mixture of residential, commercial and civic uses. The proposed scheme aims to having planning granted by Q1 2025 for Phase 1 consisting of circa 219 residential units.

## **GALWAY UNIVERSITIES**

Galway is home to two main universities, the University of Galway, and Atlantic Technological University (ATU), collectively attracting over 22,000 full-time students. University of Galway is ranked joint 4th in Ireland according to the Times Higher Education rankings 2024.

University of Galway is planning to invest €200 million on developing disused sites in the city centre and it's Strategic Plan 2020-2025, includes plans for a new innovation district on Nuns' Island. The plan has been developed in partnership with Galway City Council as part of their wider city development plan.

The CÚRAM research centre at University of Galway is establishing a global hub of research expertise in medical device technology. BioInnovate, a national training programme, offers fellowships at University of Galway and BioExcel is a medtech accelerator programme partnered with University of Galway.

Atlantic Technological University (ATU) is one of the largest multicampus universities in Ireland, offering a combination of academic and research excellence, quality of life and opportunity. Atlantic TU's collaborative approach allows practice-orientated study, and research that seeks to address the major challenges facing society and the world. As a TU of scale, quality and impact, the University will have greater capacity for collaboration with international partners. The Atlantic Language School, established in 1993, has built its global reputation as one of the premium choice English Language schools in Ireland.

Galway is now considered an internationallyrecognised MedTech hub, alongside San Francisco, Boston, Minneapolis, Singapore and Berlin. University of Galway is a key academic partner with MedTech companies, with collaboration across the Universities' research community, clinical colleagues and industry partners.
